The courses listed below are for ERASMUS students (except those registered with the Faculty of Laws) and MA European Studies students who are instructed to do EST1022.

Law students (including visiting) are not allowed to take any unit in the general field of European Union Law taught outside the Faculty, if a substantially similar unit is offered by the Faculty in particular through the Department of European and Comparative Law.
