### **Semester 2 (February 2006-June 2006)**

HPS 1009 Spanish & Latin American Film +	4 ECTS
HPS 2003 Introduction to Spanish Contemporary Literature +	4 ECTS
HPS 2004 Introduction to Latin American Literature +	4 ECTS

N.B. Students may register for any study units in any semester, subject to a minimum of 10 ECTS but those students whose Spanish language skills are relatively undeveloped are strongly advised to take HPS 2001. They are also obliged to register for optional study units, which may be taken from any area of study (including their Main or Subsidiary area), to the value of 8 ECTS.

#### **NOTES**

1. A student opting for Hispanic Studies as a Subsidiary will do a minimum of 36 ECTS in the area but exposure can be increased if s/he selects her or his options from Hispanic Studies.
2. *All* students taking Hispanic Studies will be required to take study units to improve their Spanish language skills but each student will have the opportunity to opt for a range of pathways as follows:
  - (a) A more traditional literature-based pathway.
  - (b) An area studies-based pathway which emphasises contemporary aspects of Spain and Latin America.
  - (c) A variable mix of (a) and (b).
