GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS (GIS)

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

This course is aimed for those who wish to use GIS software package in their work and research, including EU projects. It should be especially useful to those who have an interest in land use and its geographic, environmental and socio-economic implications. The course will cover theoretical and practical aspects and will offer hands-on training to participants.

DATES AND TIMES

The course will be spread over 8 weekends (48 hours of tuition), commencing on Friday 8th June 2007. Lectures will be held on Friday evenings from 1700 to 2000 hrs and on Saturday mornings from 0900 to 1200 hrs.

- 2: Technological Aspects
- 3: Geographic Information and EU Projects
- 4: Case Studies
- 5: Practical sessions

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must normally have an 'O' Level standard of Education including passes in Mathematics and English. Applicants without these qualifications may be admitted, provided that the Board of Studies of this course is satisfied that the applicant can follow the course with profit.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is Lm100 (€232.94) per person, covering tuition, course notes and use of computers.

CERTIFICATES

Candidates who pass the final written examination will be awarded a Certificate of Successful Completion. Participants who opt not to sit for the final examination and who attend at least 80% of the sessions will be awarded a Certificate of Attendance.
